Note 4: Caribbean Weather SSB Net also broadcasts at AST 0630 and 0730 on 8137 USB, AST 0800 on 4030 USB, and after the AST 0830 broadcast at approximately 0900 on 12359 USB. Generally, he does not broadcast on Sunday.

- WWV has World Marine Storm Warnings (Voice) at 8 minutes, and Solar Flux (Sunspot) numbers at 18 minutes after each hour on 2.500, 5.000, 10.000, 15.000, 20.000 MHz, AM.
- During hurricane activity, information can be found on the Hurricane Watch Net (ham) continuously on 14325.
- If you are stuck waiting for a 'weather window' there is news, entertainment and sports on BBC at UTC 1000-1400 (6195 AM), UTC 2100-2400 (5975 AM); or American Forces Network, 24 hours/day (7507.0, 5446.5, 12133.5 USB).
- Updated weather report frequencies at WLO.
- The German net apparently also provides weather information at UTC 1300 (8140 USB). We have also been given information on a French weather broadcast at UTC 1140 (13640 AM and 15515 AM). There are Italian and Swedish nets, and many other languages have nets, too, but until we learn enough of all those languages to verify the info, we'll stick with listing English-language broadcasts in this format, twice a year — winter and summer.
